



## The Cavendish School

Dear Parent/Carer

With the end of the school year fast approaching I have great pleasure in inviting all of our Year 10 students to spend a day in The Cavendish School 6<sup>th</sup> Form. In recent years our schools 6<sup>th</sup> form has excelled when comparing both A level and vocational courses results with other similar schools in Hemel Hempstead and beyond. Ofsted have rated our 6<sup>th</sup> Form provision as 'good' in the last 2 inspections and as the new Director of Post 16 Learning I feel it is essential for our students to experience this part of the school before entering Year 11. We are lucky enough to base our 6<sup>th</sup> Form provision on a different site from the main school just across Gadebridge Road in the adjoining building with Gade Valley Primary School. Lots of our younger students will not have visited the 6<sup>th</sup> Form Centre yet so this is an opportunity to dress like a 6<sup>th</sup> former for the day, meet the 6<sup>th</sup> Form Pastoral Team, visit the Study Area and experience 6<sup>th</sup> form lessons that are not taught in the lower school.

On **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July** all Year 10 students will be based at the 6<sup>th</sup> Form Centre for the day.

I have attached a timetable for the day below.

Year 12 will be running the 6<sup>th</sup> Form Tuck Shop at both break and lunch time. If students wish to purchase from the Tuck Shop a small amount of cash should be brought into school on the day. Students can either bring their own packed lunch or return to the Main Site at Lunch Time but **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE SCHOOL SITE at LUNCH TIME.**

### Dress Code

Our 6<sup>th</sup> Form Dress Code requires students to come to school in Business Dress. I am not requesting that students go and purchase new suits for this day but Year 10s are asked to come in smart clothes. For example if your son does not own his own suit he could wear his school trousers, white shirt and a tie. Your daughter could wear a skirt, formal blouse and jacket. Leather shoes for both boys and girls.

If students feel more comfortable then normal school uniform could be worn.

**Strictly no DENIM or TRAINERS- normal school rules will be applied if students arrive inappropriately dressed.**

This is a really exciting opportunity for students to experience Post 16 life and begin to think about life beyond Key Stage 4.
