WHSFP offers students a wide range of courses across three schools in Hemel Hempstead providing you with the very best opportunity to excel in your sixth form courses in order to progress to Higher Education or other pathways after Year 13.

Please indicate on the application form the courses that you would like to study in Year 12 (mark the courses 1 to 3, 1 being your first choice). Your choices should be sensible and based on your current predicted grades, the entry criteria for the course(s) and the combination that is going to allow you to achieve the highest grades possible in order to maximise your choices on leaving school. Although each applicant will be considered on an individual basis the average GCSE points score required for a programme of 3 A-Levels will normally be 4.5, for 4 A-Levels it is 7.0 and for a mixture of A-Levels and BTEC students must satisfy the requirements of the individual courses.

WHSFP will consider your options along with information from your school and confirm the offer by the end of the Spring Term. In order to ensure as many students as possible are allocated their chosen options you may be assigned to a class at a school other than your own within WHSFP, but every effort will be made to ensure that you take as many courses as possible in your own school. If very few students choose a particular course it may not run.

This completed form should be signed by both student and parent/carer and returned to your Head of Sixth Form by **Thursday 9th February 2017**. Forms received after this date will be dealt with as late applications.
